The farmers market will continue July 29 and on the last two Saturdays in August and September. It will be hosted from 10 a.m. to noon those days at Village Hall, 1 Store Hill Rd., rain or shine.

The market features the wares of Old-Westbury based Pietro Farms, but the village is also looking for additional vendors.

Trustee Leslie Fastenberg said that the goal is to “create the communal experience that is very often lost in a village where people tend to be more isolated.”
